

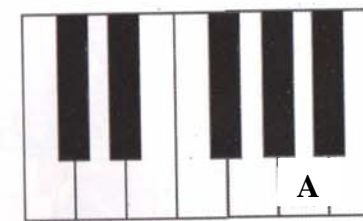

Argentinean Princess

Note A

ON THE KEYBOARD:



Note A is an *Argentinean Princess* note. It sits in the *second space* of the staff.

Assignments:

1. Find and circle all the notes A in this melody; answer the following questions: a) is the note A *line* or *space* note? (Circle the correct answer); b) which space does it sit in? First second third (circle the correct answer); c) By which hand is the note A played? Left right (circle the correct answer).
2. Clap and *count* the song above; write the counts above the grand staff;
3. Clap and *name the notes*, write the note names under the notes;
4. Find the *repeats*, *steps* and *skips* in this melody; circle repeats in **blue**, steps in **green**, and skips in **red**;
5. Play the song with both hands (the top staff – R.H., the bottom staff – L.H.); left hand should be in the five-note position (from C to G); use fingers 2 and 4 for the right hand part (do not forget to REPEAT the song. Play the first time FORTE, and the second time - PIANO).
6. Play the song and say the counts; then play again and *name* the notes.
