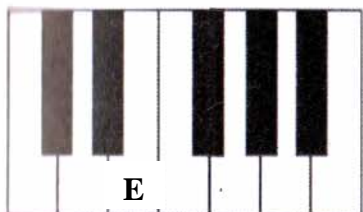


ON THE KEYBOARD:

ON THE STAFF:

Note E is an *Egyptian Princess* note. It sits on the *first line* of the staff.

### Assignments:

- 1) Find all notes E on the keyboard (in both high and low registers);
- 2) Add *stems* to the notes E on the staff above. Which *note values* did you get? \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_
- 3) Add the *time signature* 4/4 after treble clef; then add the *bar lines*. How many *measures* did you get? \_\_\_\_\_
- 4) Clap and count the song you just created; write the counts above the notes;
- 5) Play the *note E* on the keyboard; use finger 2, R.H., for the first time, and finger 3, R.H., for the second time.
